AIEL admissions will issue a Letter of Offer (LOO) and send it to you or your agent.

Note: AIEL may issue a Conditional LOO where required documentation is missing from our application or AIEL may refuse to issue a LOO where we have concerns that an applicant may not present as a 'genuine student'.



You sign the LOO as acceptance of AIEL's terms and conditions, you make the payment indicated in the schedule of fees and you meet any conditions listed in the LOO.

AIEL reserves the right to withdraw the LOO at any time.



Send the fully completed GTE form and applicant declaration.



AIEL will evaluate your GTE form and then will issue an Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE) where:

- 1. Your LOO and GTE are assessed as meeting AIEL entry conditions and requirements.
- 2. AIEL are satisfied that you are a person genuinely seeking to enter Australia for the purpose of studying our English course/s.

When you receive the eCOE, you or your agent can now apply for a student visa, or you may ask AIEL for assistance in this regard.



After the visa is granted, you can then travel to Australia to commence your studies.
