ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- International students must be 18 years of age or over.
- Students are required to successfully complete the Language Literacy and Numeracy test and achieve Level

3 in the Australian Core Skills Framework across reading, writing, learning, oral communication and numeracy skill. Prospective students who provides an AQF Certificate III or above in any discipline will be deemed as meeting the English language entry requirements. Prospective International students who provide an IELTS of 5.5 or its equivalent will be deemed as meeting the English language entry requirements.
